CrowdStrike Stock Drops After Outage Hits Companies Globally

CrowdStrike shares tumbled in morning trading, after a software update from the cybersecurity company caused widespread outages for millions of users of Microsoft Windows devices worldwide.

In recent trading:

- CrowdStrike shares (CRWD) stood more than 8% lower, at slightly over \$312.
- Microsoft stock (MSFT) was roughly flat at \$440.90.
- Shares in SentinelOne (S), a rival to CrowdStrike, rose about 4% to around \$21.
